THE WORLD PREMIERE MUSICAL OF THE SNOWY DAY AT ADVENTURE THEATRE

Celebrating the 50th Anniversary of this beloved children's book Script by Helen Hayes Nominated playwright David Emerson Toney

GLEN ECHO, MD – <u>Adventure Theatre</u> continues its **2011-2012 60**th **Anniversary Season and it's African-American Adventures Series** with *The Snowy Day*, January 20-February 12, 2012 based on the first American picture book to feature an African-American child as the main character by Ezra Jack Keats.

The simple tale of a boy waking up to discover that snow has fallen during the night is brought to life in the magical world premiere musical. Peter celebrates the snow-draped inner city with a day of adventures-experimenting with footprints, knocking snow from a tree, creating snow angels, and trying to save a snowball for the next day.

Directed by Jessica Burgess with music and lyrics by Howard University's Darius Smith, this show is the second of Adventure Theatre's *African American Adventures Series*, a series of five world-premiere musicals based on the African-American experience written by African-American artists. Children under the age of 1 are free. **The press performance will be Sunday, January 22 at 2pm**. All performances will take place at Adventure Theatre, 7300 MacArthur Blvd, Glen Echo, MD, 20812 in the historic Glen Echo Park.
