ATMTC ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIPS

Public elementary schools in Montgomery County do not offer theatre/drama programming. The Adventure Theatre Academy provides structured, inspiring drama programs taught by local teaching professionals. Our classes focus on building skills demonstrated to build self-confidence, communication, and teamwork skills, and improve kids' standardized test scores and school attendance.
